### Zoom Lecture: "Wo man singt: German-American Singing Festivals, 1849-1914"

From 1849 to 1914, German-American singing festivals were a constant yet changing element in the cultural landscape of the US. This presentation by Heike Bungert, Professor for North American History at the University of Münster in Germany, will focus on the beginnings and expansion of German-American choirs, especially *Männerchöre*, singing federations and their festivals, and the musical repertoire that was performed from the mid-19th century to WWI.
